

# DYNAMITE & CRACKERJACK SERIES 2016-2017

## BMX Sports Western Australia Guidelines

The 2017 National Dynamite & Crackerjack Champions are decided at the Australian National Championships. The finals showcase the best riders from across Australia, with each rider representing their State and competes in their State Jersey.

The 2016/2017 BMXWA Dynamite and Crackerjack Series is part of the rider selection procedure for the Teams to represent WA at the 2017 National Dynamite & Crackerjack Finals.

### Team Selection

A maximum of 3 riders will be selected for each class. To qualify for team selection riders must intend to nominate for the 2017 National Championships.

The top ranked rider in each class for the 2016/2017 BMXWA Dynamite & Crackerjack Series will be nominated for the team. The second and third place positions will be filled at the discretion of the BMXWA Selection Committee. The selectors aim is to provide a Team most likely to podium.

In the event of Injury, Illness or other unforeseen circumstances, the BMXWA Selection Committee may nominate replacement riders to the Team for top up to the three (3) riders maximum per class.

### Events

The WA Dynamite & Crackerjack Series will be conducted over 4 rounds as set out by BMX Australia. These 4 rounds will consist of:

1. 2016 Wanneroo Rd 3 Super Series
2. 2016 Cockburn Rd 5 Super Series
3. 2016 Rockingham Rd 9 Super Series (double points)
4. 2016 BMXWA State Championships

### Qualification

Riders must nominate in their natural age and gender 20 inch Expert (where both Novice and Expert classes are offered) class to receive Dynamite & Crackerjack Series ranking points for first place.

- The Dynamite Series is open to all Western Australian licensed riders who have reached the ages of 11, 12 and 13 years on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017 and compete in **EXPERT** classes.
- The Crackerjack Series is open to all Western Australian licenced riders who have reached the ages of 9 & 10 on the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017 and compete in **EXPERT** classes.
- The Dynamite & Crackerjack Series is open to riders wishing to compete at the Dynamite & Crackerjack Series Finals at the 2017 National Championships in Sleeman.
- Riders must have competed in 2016 State Championships and in three (3) out of the four (4) of the rounds in the Dynamite & Crackerjack Series. Round three (3) will attract double points (Rd 9 2016 Super Series Rockingham).

- Points Scoring Table will be as below: This points table relates to a 3 moto's and final format.

- The State Selectors will be responsible for the selection of the State Team to compete in the Dynamite & Crackerjack Series National Final. Selectors decision is final.
- Selection will take place after round 4 (2016 State Championships) of the Dynamite & Crackerjack Series, all riders selected will be notified in writing.
- There will be 3 riders selected from each age group of both Boys and Girls.
- BMX Sports Western Australia will provide a Team Manager for the National Dynamite & Crackerjack Finals.
- Coaching support will be available to the team in the lead up to the National Dynamite & Crackerjack Finals.
- All selected riders will receive a State Dynamite & Crackerjack Jersey which must be worn at the event.
- There is no charge for entry to the Dynamite & Crackerjack Finals event in Sleeman.
