



BMX SPORTS WESTERN AUSTRALIA 2018 STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS TEAM ENTRY INFORMATION & RULES

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is restricted to BMX Sports WA affiliated Club / Family teams and Corporate Teams.

There will be two (2) Team competitions if entries permit. Teams must adhere to these regulations and follow the Rules and Responsibilities.

At these State Championships six (6) teams will constitute a competition class. If less than six teams in either category then the Teams Competition will be combined to incorporate both Family/Club and Corporate Teams.

ENTRIES

Team entries must enter using a manual entry form. The team rules and entry form will be available from www.bmxsportswa.com.au

Team entries will close on Friday 21st September 2018. Submit via email:

NOTE: after closing time Team Managers may advise the scoring coordinator of a substitute rider to replace a nominated rider who is unable to compete due to injury.

Any changes advised later that 1 hour prior to the commencement of racing each day will not be accepted.

DEFINITIONS

Teams covered in the competition:

Family / Club Teams

Teams entered either by a registered BMX Club or an unsponsored team entered by a family or group of families.

Corporate Teams:

Teams entered by Pro Shops, Manufacturers, Business Houses and other interested groups.

TEAM MANAGERS

Each team will appoint a Team manager who will be responsible for:

- Registration and entry of their Team
- The entry of not more than 6 and not less than 4 riders at the close of registration.
- The collation of each team riders points.
- Should the Team Manager disagree with the official posted Team Results, a protest must be lodged no later than 15 minutes after this posting.

ENTRY FEES

An entry fee of \$70.00 shall accompany the Team Entry form. Note: This fee will be non-refundable.

TEAM MAKEUP

Each team is to consist of no less than 4 and no more than 6 riders.

No team shall have more than two (2) Female Riders and two (2) Cruiser Riders.

No rider is permitted to ride in more than one (1) class in the team competition.

When 2 Team Events are held,

Ie. Family/Club and Corporate then a rider will only be permitted to compete for 1 Event. A rider may also not be entered in any more than one team.

There will be no limits to the number of teams that a Club, Family or Corporate entity may enter.

TEAM SCORING

Points will be awarded in each moto and the final as follows.

1st	20 pts	5 th	12 pts
2 nd	18 pts	6 th	10 pts
3 rd	16 pts	7 th	8 pts
4 th	14 pts	8 th	6 pts

No points will be awarded for eighth, Qtr and Semi-finals. However bonus points will be awarded to riders who COMPETE in an eighth, Qtr or semi-final.

Eighth Final	2 bonus points
Quarter Final	3 bonus points
Semi Final	4 bonus points

These points are cumulative.

In the event of a tie between teams the results will be decided by:

- Greatest number of deadman final wins
- Greatest number of points gained in deadman finals
- Greatest number of bonus points
- Toss of a coin

Posting of Team Results will be effected shortly after the conclusion of racing. It is the Team Managers responsibility to check the posted results against their own calculations and to lodge any protest to these results within 15 minutes should they disagree.

TEAM REQUIREMENTS

Corporate Sponsored Teams must wear full team uniform and must use the Teams primary product or products whilst competing.

Club / Family Teams must at the least display their Club / Family logo or insignia (min size 4cm x 8 cm) on the left shoulder or left breast of each of the team riders.

The winning teams will each receive Medallions for all riders and a Team Trophy.
(Team manager to receive medallion also)
