2020 STATE CHAMPIONSHIP FAQ

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Registration?

A: Registration is held on Thursday 8th October. It is compulsory that all riders entered have their licence scanned and collect their State Championship race plate at registration. (Registration times are available on the schedule)

Q: Do I have to attend Registration in person?

A: Anyone can attend for you, as long as they have a current copy of the riders licence to be scanned.

If you are unable to attend or have someone attend for you, please email BMXWA on or before Wednesday 7th October. (Note your plate will need to be collected and put on your bike before going onto the track on Friday or Saturday practice sessions)

Q: What do I do if I have any Racing questions or problems during the day?

A: Please see the Riders Advocate ONLY they will assist you with your questions. (Riders advocate will be announced each day – and where they will be located)

Q: What is the BMXWA Code of Conduct?

A: The purpose of the BMXWA Code of Conduct is to describe the type of behaviour BMXWA is seeking to promote and encourage its members and supporters to adopt this Code of Conduct. Q: When and where will Mini Wheeler trophies be presented?

A: Mini Wheelers will be presented with their Trophy at Rockingham BMX Club approximately 10 minutes at the conclusion of their racing.

Q: When and where will Sprocket, Cruiser and 20" trophies be presented?

A: Awards will be presented approximately 30 Minutes after the final race at Mike Barnett Sports Centre, Dixon Rd &, Goddard St, Rockingham WA 6168.

All riders MUST wear full racing attire at the awards presentations. (Except your helmet)

Q: What is the "Parade of Riders" on Friday morning?

A: All clubs are invited to take part in the riders parade, dress in your club colours, some clubs even have a war cry they have done in the past. The winning club "Best Presented" will be judged and presented on the morning.
